2012 Minutes

President's Update

Roger Slater welcomed everyone to the AGM and thanked them for taking the time to attend. Roger presented a summary of the year. Highlights included:

- The growth in use of the RAYC as a club base (with exciting future development to create a multisport hub)
- The various coaching activities including the introduction of the beginners' squad
- Another successful Pukekohe Raceway event (be it lower in numbers this year due to the timing of the event)

Finances:

Roger presented the 2013 Finances for the year ended 30 June 2013. These are currently with Bruce Chambers (Honorary Auditor) and are thus subject to auditing.

The 2013 year ended with a \$5,370 surplus but also excludes a \$3,065 Accounts Payable accrual for RAYC club room costs yet to be invoiced.

Overall the club is in good shape with \$18,534 Retained Earnings.

The Finances and President's Update were approved (Roger-proposed/Rob-2nd)

Honorariums:

It was proposed and carried that the honorary positions be retained, with appreciation of the great benefit they provide the club.

These were approved as follows:

Honorary Solicitor – Bill Manning (Roger-proposed/Lynley-2nd)
Honorary Auditor – Bruce Chambers (Roger-proposed/Tony-2nd)

Note, a \$150 donation is provided to Bruce's charity of choice which is the Whitianga Bike Trail.

Award Recognitions:

Time was then taken to recognise the various high achievers in the club who had won club champ titles and represented NZ at world championships.

Cameron Brown then presented the Cup for the top age group performance at a world championship event which was awarded to Martina Fellmann for her 3rd place in London

Cameron also spoke about a charity event he is currently involved with and the club agreed to donate \$50 to this as a thank you for Cameron's time.

Membership Fees:

It was proposed by the current committee that the membership fees be maintained at the same level: \$50 Senior; \$30 Under23. It was added that these are amongst the lowest around and offer excellent value.

Proposed that committee receive no honorarium.
